Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program

The 2021-2022 Low-Income Home Energy Assistance Program (LIHEAP) has been established to help qualifying low-income Iowa homeowners and renters pay a portion of their primary heating costs for the winter heating season. The assistance is based on household income, household size, type of fuel, and type of housing.

Things to bring with you when applying:

Proof of Income: Documents that offer proof of total household gross income from all sources for the past month or past calendar year. We must have complete proof of income to process your application.

- ❖ **Fixed Income:** This income may include: Social Security Benefits, Supplemental Security Income, Family Investment Program, Veterans' Assistance, Unemployment Insurance and Pensions. Please bring a copy of your most recent month check stubs or other proof of income. (If using bank statement, it cannot be redacted)
- ❖ **Wage Earners:** Copies of your check stubs for the four weeks preceding the date of application or a copy of your Federal Income Tax Return.
- ❖ **Self-Employment/Farmers:** A copy of your most recent Federal Income Tax Return.
- ❖ **FIP and SSI Recipients:** Please bring your current DHS Notice of Decision.
- ❖ If you receive **alimony, child support, or rental income**, it will also need to be verified.

Social Security Numbers: For all household members (documentation required if not on file).

Bills: A copy of your most recent HEATING and ELECTRICAL.
